### Prayer



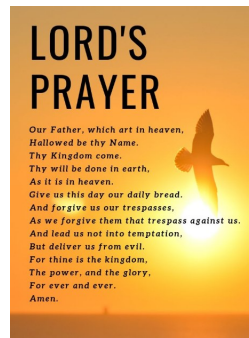
We will be finding out why Christians believe prayer is important and the ways in which they pray.

Respect is an essential part of a Jew's faith. Jew's believe that the 10 commandments are rules that teach them how to live and must be followed.

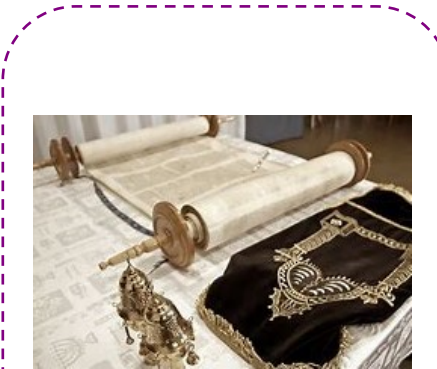
### Importance of Worship.
