Reception Cohort Profile

- 81 pupils (49 boys and 32 girls).
- 6% of the cohort (5 children) are taught within Fig - one of the specialist SEN provisions.
- 8.6% of pupils have an Educational, Health and Care Plan- EHC plan (on average 5.3% of primary school pupils have an EHC Plan)
- 28.3% of other pupils are registered as SEND support or have an additional need on the school's SEND register (on average 14.2% of primary school pupils have special educational needs (SEN) support, but don't have an EHC plan).

- 28.1% of other pupils are registered as SEND support or have an additional need on the school's SEND register (on average 14.2% of primary school pupils have special educational needs (SEN) support, but don't have an EHC plan).
- 32.8% of the cohort are eligible for free school meals- FSM (on average 26.5% of pupils are eligible for FSM)
