



Provisional Key Stage 2 SATs Results 2026

Cohort Profile

- 89 pupils (43 boys and 46 girls).
- 8.9% of pupils have an Educational, Health and Care Plan- EHC plan (on average 5.3% of primary school pupils have an EHC Plan)
- 11.2% of other pupils are registered as SEND support or have an additional need on the school's SEND register (on average 14.2% of primary school pupils have special educational needs (SEN) support, but don't have an EHC plan).
- 37% of the cohort are eligible for free school meals- FSM (on average 26.5% of pupils are eligible for FSM)

Science

89% (National average 82%) of Year 6 pupils have made the expected standard in science.

Scaled Scores

A scaled score of 100 represents the expected standard for each test. The highest scaled score possible is 120 and the lowest is 80. Pupils working at greater depth achieved a scaled score of 110+. The **school's scaled score averages** this year were: **Reading: 107** (*National Average 106*), **Spelling Punctuation and Grammar (SPaG): 108** (*National Average 105*) and **Maths: 107** (*National Average 105*).
